

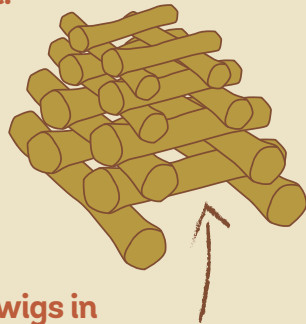


Be a woodland artist

- 1 Gather some twigs of different lengths and thicknesses.
- 2 Choose a flat spot to build your tower. The area under a tree is perfect.



- 3 Place the biggest twigs in a square or triangular shape, or dream up your own design.

- 4 Add your twigs one by one and see how high your tower can go.

Make a low branch or tree trunk part of your sculpture by building around it.
