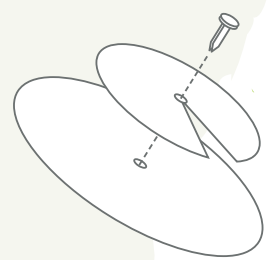

Top tips for top spotters!

- Take a pair of binoculars.
- Make sure you're really quiet.
- Look for birds in the trees and on the ground.

Did you know long-tailed tits take around three weeks to build their nests?

The goldcrest is the UK's smallest bird. It's only about 9cm long and weighs between 4.5 and 7 grams!
